P.J. Passes the IRL Infiniti Pro-Series Rookie Test

During the week of December 8-10, 2003, P.J. Abbott participated in his IRL test session in Las Vegas, Nevada. The test was conducted under the direction of Sam Schmidt and his team. Following 2 days of mechanical challenges, P.J. hit the track running in the IRL #20 Dallara. Meeting his objective, Abbott completed the requirements for the 2004 Infiniti Pro-Series as well as the first four requirements of the IRL rookie test. Getting up to speed came "quickly" as he smoothly eclipsed the 200 mph barrier around the 1.5 mile Las Vegas super speedway oval. Final laps were clocked at over 210 mph.
